TRUTH TALK is part of the Abstinence Education Program, a service of the Evansville Christian Life Center.

The purpose is to help students connect their Friday night to their future. With a whole person health perspective, students are taught ways to have healthy and positive relationships.

Our commitment is to provide truthful information in an engaging and non-judgmental environment, without sharing personal beliefs.

We have trained facilitators who present TRUTH TALK to schools and community agencies. These facilitators have attended training with CPR, the Creating Positive Relationships curriculum that is utilized in public schools across the nation.

This program also offers ways for parents to get more involved in the TRUTH TALK dialogue. Some opportunities include parent nights and after school events. Parent programs will vary among schools.

Ask your child's school to start the dialogue about healthy relationships by including TRUTH TALK in their health or after school programs, along with a parent event.
